Criteria for Student Delegates:

1. Academic Standing:

- Students must be currently enrolled in grades 9th through 11th at O. D. Wyatt High School, Dunbar High School, Eastern Hills High School, or Poly High School
- Or currently enrolled in grades 9th through 11th at any high school in Tarrant County and his or her family receives verifiable SNAP, CHIP and or Federal Housing Assistance.
- Report card showing **passing grades** is required along with exceptional or **above-average conduct**.

2. Teacher Recommendations:

- Students must provide **two teacher recommendations**. These recommendations should highlight the student's character, work ethic, and potential for growth.

3. Personal Qualities:

- Students should demonstrate qualities such as being **manageable, respectful, and well-kept**.
- We seek participants who will represent their schools and community with pride.

4. Parental Consent:

- Parents or legal guardians must agree to their child's participation in the trip.
- A signed consent form is mandatory.
- Parent or guardian must cooperate and assist “volunteer pre-trip sponsors” with completing and gathering documents (timely) and attend scheduled appointments and meetings.

5. Gender of Students:

A maximum of 8 boys and 8 girls will be able to participate. This activity is available to all students without regard to race, religion, ethnicity, orientation, or disability.
